## DRIVER EDUCATION

To successfully complete the class and receive a certificate of completion, students must attend the mandated 30 hours of instruction required by Pennsylvania regulations and pass the written test. Graduates may qualify for an auto insurance discount.

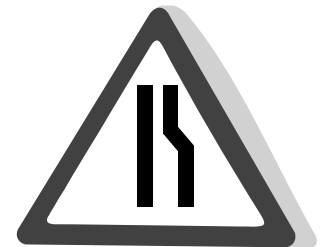
