The Summer Bridge program is designed to provide incoming 9th grade students with a “head start” on their high school experience. Research has shown that to achieve a seamless transition for students from grades 8 to 9, students need extensive exposure to high school expectations during the summer before 9th grade begins. *The goal of the Summer Bridge program is to help students adjust to high school and give them the confidence to perform well academically while feeling comfortable socially.*
