### **105.1 Curriculum Organization**

*It is the Board's desire to provide instructional improvement and curricular development through a system which provides for interaction between: teacher and teacher; teacher and administrator; and parent, teacher and administrators. The Board desires to receive a wide level of professional advice, provide for staff involvement on matters of curriculum and instruction, and maintain an on-going procedure for the improvement of instruction and curriculum.*

*To accomplish these goals the Board establishes a Curriculum Council composed of:*  
*Superintendent*  
*Elementary and Secondary Coordinator*  
*Building Administrators*  
*Curriculum Coordinators*

*The further provide for the establishment of Curriculum Committees under the leadership of the respective curriculum coordinators. These committees shall reflect a K-12 faculty membership with representation from each building where appropriate. Committees shall function with a minimum of seven members plus the chairperson.*

*It shall be the purpose of the curriculum committee to initiate proposals to change curriculum in their area of expertise. The committees may receive suggestions from individual teachers, building principals, parents, students or residents of the community.*

*It shall be the purpose of the Curriculum Council to review all proposals and prepare a recommendation to the Superintendent for Board consideration.*
