918 *Smoking on School Property*

The Board of School Directors of Colonial School District is committed to the provision of a healthful environment for all individuals who are associated with the district. This policy has been developed in an effort to maintain that commitment and to safeguard the entire school community against the harmful effects of smoking.

Smoking is not permitted on school property. This prohibition applies to students, non-students, and adults (employees and non-employees). The definition of "school property" includes school buildings, school buses, all other school vehicles and real estate owned or leased by the school district.

The definition of "smoking" includes the lighting of a cigarette, cigar, or pipe, and also includes the use of smokeless tobacco in any form.

This policy applies immediately to all students, and will become applicable to adults (employees and non-employees) as of June 30, 1992. The policy applies to all programs conducted by the Colonial School District as well as to all programs conducted on the property of the school district.

The Superintendent of Schools shall establish appropriate administrative regulations to carry out the above policy.
